VOTER SAFETY GUIDE

Before you vote, please read through this entire guide, then print, including ballot-order recommendations. Bring it with you to the poll – you cannot use your phone.

You may vote at any vote center in the county – site lookup is at dallascountyvotes.org

- 1. Perform a "Voter Lookup" on yourself and check your status online.
 - a. Find your sample ballot and mail-in ballot status under Voter Lookup at dallascountyvotes.org
 - b. Check status. If you did not submit a request for a mail-in ballot, there should not be a reference to "Mail Ballot Status". If it says, "Mail Ballot Status", there will be dates of:
 - i. Application Received MM/DD/YYYY
 - ii. Mailed Date MM/DD/YYY
 - iii. Ballot Received MM/DD/YYYY
- 2. Bring your ID to vote Acceptable IDs include:
 - a. Texas driver's license (not a limited term ID)
 - b. U.S. passport
 - c. License to carry
- 3. Bring TWO additional items:
 - a. This 2-page Voters Guide (phones aren't allowed while voting)
 - Voter registration card to verify your ballot has the correct candidates. Some voters have received incorrect ballots. Your card lists district number for: U.S. Representative, State Senator, State Representative, County Commissioner, Judges, City Council, ISD (School Board District)
- 4. Check for a preprinted number on your ballot
 - a. This is required by law for audits and tracking purposes.
- 5. Verify there is an "HG" initial stamp (Early Voting) or Signature (Election Day) on the back of your ballot
 - a. There should be **no writing on the front** until heading printed for you.
- 6. On completion of making voting selections, confirm the printed ballot matches your selections
 - a. ***Check it before placing it in the tabulator for counting.
- 7. Report any ballot issues immediately
 - a. Speak to the PEO/Election Judge **before** inserting it into the tabulator.
